To fully enjoy your visit, please acquaint yourself with our established customs and rules. Guests utilizing the Club will be responsible for meeting the Club's House Rules during their visit.

Dress Code

Proper attire is always required in the common areas, the golf areas and around the Clubhouse. Golf areas are the golf course, practice range, practice pitching and chipping areas, and putting greens. The club management has made general adherence to the dress code a priority for the golf staff. The golf staff is asked to withhold playing privileges for members or their guests who are not properly attired. The dress code applies to all golfers of all ages.

- Men must have a collared shirt and sleeves. Mock neck shirts are acceptable.
- All shirts must be tucked in. No exceptions.
- No denim allowed.
- Soft spikes or tennis shoes are mandatory.
- Ladies are permitted to wear collarless golf shirts with sleeves.
- Ladies are permitted to wear sleeveless shirts, but they must have a collar.
- Cell phones are permitted but should not disrupt the flow of play.
- Hats must be worn with the bill forward.

Cell Phones Usage

Permissible Use - Cell phone conversations are not allowed in the Main Dining Room or Member Grille. Members or guests receiving cell phone calls in a restricted area must move outside to continue a conversation. Cell phones must be off or in silent mode and conversations must be continued in an allowed area.

Pace of Play

Members and guests are expected to play 18 holes in four hours or less. Please always play ready golf. Please pick up if you are out of the hole and putt continuously when appropriate.

If you are driving a golf cart, please follow all directional signs and use cart paths when designated to do so. The responsible operation of golf carts will help preserve the pristine playing condition of our playing surfaces.

If your group is approached by a club employee about pace of play, please do whatever is necessary to keep up with the group in front of you.

Smoking

The club will observe a NO-SMOKING Policy on the golf course. Vaping and e-cigarettes are still permitted on the golf course. Smoking is permitted on the Men's and Women's Lounge patios and in the outdoor Cigar lounge.

Food & Beverage

The Golf Shop is stocked with coffee and tea from 7:00 am to 11:00 am daily. During the week our kitchen opens at 11:00 am for lunch service and we invite you to enjoy lunch in the clubhouse or on the patio overlooking the 18th hole prior to or following your round. Breakfast items such as Breakfast burrito and Sandwiches are available beginning at 8:00AM to order during the week through the Golf Shop. All food and beverage may be purchased by use of Credit Card.
